Deadline Date: April 30, 2010

Eligibility Requirements:

- 30 credits or more toward a college degree with good grades
- Enrolled in classes which constitute part of her degree program
- (Official or Unofficial) Transcript of completed courses
- Completed Application Form (see back)
- Statement of financial situation (see application form) *"Financial need is, of course, important, but so are academic achievement, community activity and that intangible quality that says, 'This is a woman who is going to take active control of her life.'"*
- Brief typed statement (500 words max.) of her professional hopes, plans, dreams, etc.
- Send Transcript, Completed Application form and Statement of Plans to:
