Futurama Youth Scholarship in Memory of Rachel E. Lemieux

Information for Scholarship Applicants

BPW/Maine, through the **BPW/Maine Futurama Foundation**, awards a scholarship in the amount of **\$1200** in memory of Rachel E. Lemieux. Miss Lemieux was a member of the Augusta BPW and served the Maine Federation on both the Futurama and the Scholarship Committees.

The Youth Scholarship is awarded to a Maine high school senior or recent graduate who will enroll in an accredited school or college during this year.

The scholarship is designed to assist a student in meeting educational expenses for the first year of post-secondary study. *The scholarship payment will be made directly to the school to be applied to the second academic term, upon notification of the student's enrollment during that term.*

Criteria

The applicant must meet the following requirements:

1. Be a Maine resident who will graduate or has graduated from high school and who will enroll in an accredited college or school or post-secondary education this year.
2. Demonstrate financial need.
3. Have a realistic goal relating to educational plans.

Requirements

The following items must be submitted with the application:

1. Completed application form*
2. Official transcript from high school.
3. Verification of acceptance from the college or school.
4. At least three letters of recommendation as follows:
 - At least one letter from high school principal or guidance counselor**
 - At least one letter from a high school teacher**
 - At least one letter from an employer, minister, etc.
5. A signed statement by the applicant describing educational and personal goals. This should include information about applicant's financial need and family financial situation. Information about school activities, employment, and any unusual circumstances may be pertinent to include.

*No application will be considered to be complete until all supporting materials are received.

**If recent high school graduate.

The deadline for completed applications is April 20th. *Late applications will not be considered.*
