ECH 232 Social Science for the Young Child **Fridays 5-8:15P & Saturdays 8:30A-3P** **Squibb**
meets Sept. 11/12, 25/26, Oct. 16/17, Nov. 6/7, Dec. 4/5 (snow date Dec. 11/12)
Focuses on the development of curriculum in the social sciences for young children ages birth through 8. Topics include the links between cognitive development and appropriate curriculum content, development of curriculum in specific areas of the social sciences, community resources for teaching, and relevant standards for designing, implementing and assessing curriculum.
