Onsite UMF Undergraduate Courses Offered in Bath

ECHF 277 – Language Development, Literature and Early Literacy, Birth to 5 F 5:30-8:30P, S 9A-3:30P
4/24-25, 5/8-9, 5/29-30, 6/12-13, 6/26-27

Familiarizes early childhood teachers with language acquisition in children 0-5 and the connection between language development and emergent literacy. Acquaints students with the developmental stages of oral language, writing and reading, multicultural variables that impact language and literacy, and how to relate this understanding to the preschool setting. Students also learn ways of selecting and using developmentally appropriate children's literature. Credits: 4

ECHF 377 – The Reggio Emilia Approach and the Emergent Curriculum
F 5:30-8:30P, S 9A-3:30P 5/15-16, 5/22-23, 6/5-6 Monday & Tuesday evenings 6/22-23 & 7/6-7

Introduces students to the Reggio Emilia approach and the use of the emergent curriculum in early childhood education. Course begins with an overview of the history and development of the Reggio Emilia approach and moves to the pedagogical dimensions and features of the emergent curriculum as practiced in this model. The concept of pedagogical documentation is debated and used to support curriculum planning and children's assessment. EPS 512 – Response to Intervention Methods for General & Special Education (2688) 6/25-7/1 Th, F, M, T, W 8A-4P

This course provides training in knowledge and skills for the use of response to intervention (RTI) methods in school settings. Students learn how to select and use scientifically-validated intervention and assessment methods for three distinct instructional levels. Through readings, discussion, and practice students will develop the skills necessary to design, implement, and evaluate comprehensive RTI programs in school settings. Appropriate for general and special educators, school-based specialists as well as other professionals interested in scientifically-based methods of learning outcomes for all children. Course completion qualifies towards Maine Special Education Certification. Credits: 3
